Due to covid pandemic situation the academic session 2020-2021 was started in the month of December 2021, though the classes of the session were started from the month of September 2021, before the commencement of previous semester end examinations. In this session all classes and different events were organized in online mode initially through Zoom meet then Google Meet. All programmes were organized in structured and well-planned way.

- 1. Academic Calendar, Academic Plan and Time-table for online classes were prepared and uploaded in the college WEBSITE as well as the departmental websites. The same were also communicated to the students through WhatsApp groups.
- 2. Academic & Administrative Audit was done for the session 2019-2020 by a group of Principals of different colleges of West Bengal along with the IQAC coordinator of K.K.Das College on 21.12.2020.
- 3. Gender Audit for the session 2019-2020 was done internally under the supervision of the Principal, K. K. das College on 22.12.2020 .

- 7. Mentor- Mentee list for the session was prepared and communicated to all teachers and teachers were requested to keep track of their mentee.
- 8. TwoMoUsweresigned, one with SammilaniMahavidyalaya and another with VijaygarhJyotish Ray Collegefor the purpose of conducting some collaborative activities for next five years.
- 9. Five Add-On courses were offered to the students in which 107 students were enrolled.
- 10. Sixteen StudentCentric Seminars/ Workshops/Talks (Subject Oriented) were organized throughout the year.
- 11. Two Seminars were organized forthe Teachers and Students in collaboration with other institutions.
- 12. Seven Special Lectures were organized to observe some special days and to sensitize our students about different issues like gender, caste, health, environment etc.
- 13. Student and Teacher Exchange Programmeswere conducted with four colleges under MoU by four departments of the college.
- 14. Nine Cultural Events were organized to observe Special days and Seven competitions were organized among which five were inter college events.
- 15. Three Career Counselling Programmes were organized for the students.

- 17. NSS Unit and Students' Union of the college took the initiative of organizing two awareness programmes through online mode by arranging special lecture on health and the necessity of blood donation in this pandemic situation.
- 18. The NSS unit of K. K. Das college under the supervision of Principal in collaboration with the NGO GariaSahamirmi Society, conducted three activities including distribution of food and cloth to the rural marginalized people. NSS unit also conducted a blood donation camp and a covid vaccination camp.

Feedback were then analyzed and placed before GB meeting for taking action.

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
